II. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. CITY INTRODUCTION

Located in Argeș County, in the historical region of Muntenia, the twin communities of PITESTI and Bascov form one of Romania's most important centers for canoeing and water sports. Just 110 km northwest of Bucharest, the area combines the tranquillity of the Argeș River Valley with the convenience of modern infrastructure and hospitality.

PITESTI, known as the "City of Flowers," is surrounded by rolling hills, green parks, and the calm waters of the Argeș River, providing the perfect setting for outdoor activities. The city is also a vibrant cultural centre, offering visitors an authentic taste of Romanian traditions, gastronomy, and warm hospitality.

Just outside the city lies Bascov, home to the Budeasa Regatta Course, one of the best-equipped canoeing venues in Eastern Europe. The complex regularly hosts national and international canoe sprint, marathon, and dragon boat competitions, and has become a landmark for European paddlers.

2. Local Attractions

During rest days or after the competition, participants can explore:

- Curtea de Argeș Monastery, a masterpiece of Romanian architecture
- Poienari Fortress, the historic castle of Vlad the Impaler



- Transfăgărășan Road, one of Europe's most scenic mountain routes
- Local cuisine, famous for traditional dishes like "sarmale" and "mămăligă"

The region enjoys a mild continental climate in June, with average daytime temperatures between 24–28°C, making it comfortable for athletes and visitors alike.

With its blend of tradition, nature, and sporting excellence, Bascov–PITESTI offers the ideal setting for the 2026 Paddle Europe Marathon Championships — where the spirit of European canoeing continues to grow.

3. Venue Overview

The Bascov–Budeasa Regatta Course offers:

Calm and protected water ideal for marathon distances

A large finish tower and control centre

Modern athlete facilities and secure boat storage areas

Ample parking and public viewing zones

Medical, media, and hospitality areas within the venue perimeter

The course is surrounded by natural scenery — forests, farmlands, and gentle hills — giving athletes a quiet, focused environment for competition.

4. GETTING TO PITESTI

The delegation's access to the venue will be by plane, car or train.

By Plane - nearest airports are

- Official Airport: Bucharest Henri Coanda International Airport (OTP), 125 km from PITESTI (~1h30 via A1 Motorway).
- Alternative Airport: Sibiu International Airport (SBZ), 165 km (~2h30 by car).

By Car

- Western Border (Hungary / Szedeg) – 480 km
- South Border (Bulgaria / Ruse) – 156 km
- East Border (Moldavia) – 350 km

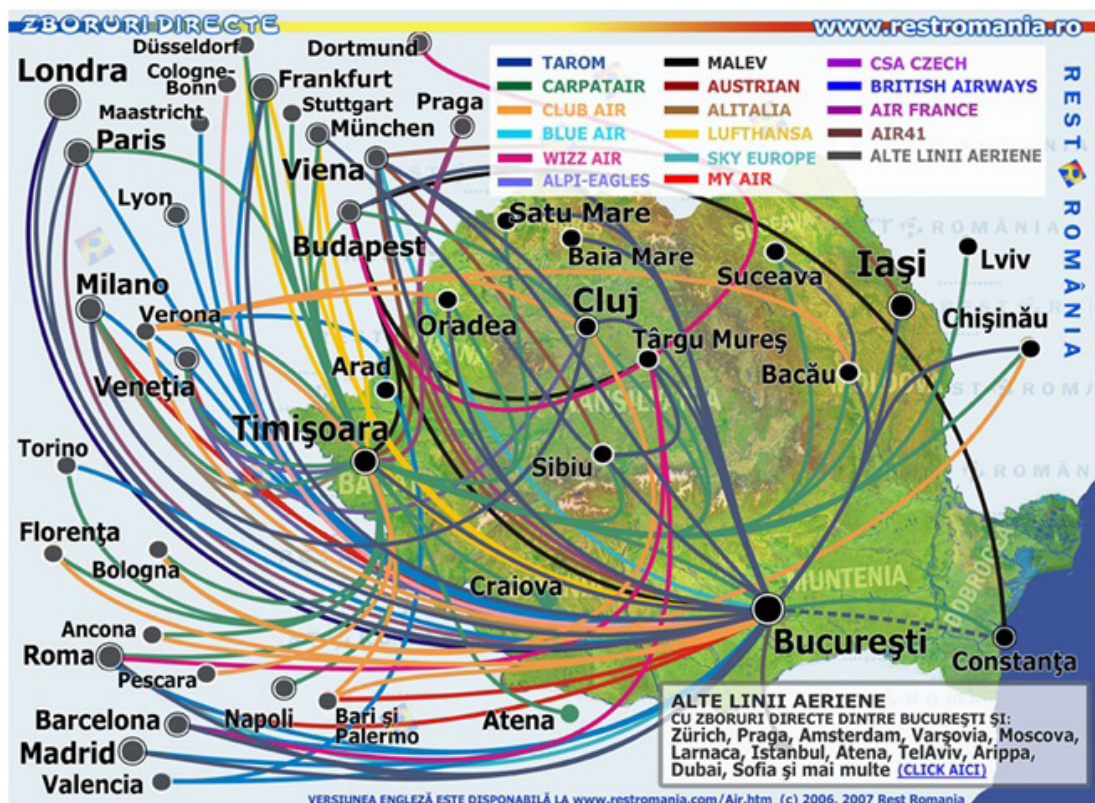
By Train

- direct access to the venue or via Bucharest (110 km)

The HOC will organize upon request the transport to/from the airports and Pitesti railways station.

During the competition transport between official hotels and venue will be organized by HOC with dedicated companies for competitors and officials.

Local transportation will be also available for supporters; taxis are available as well.

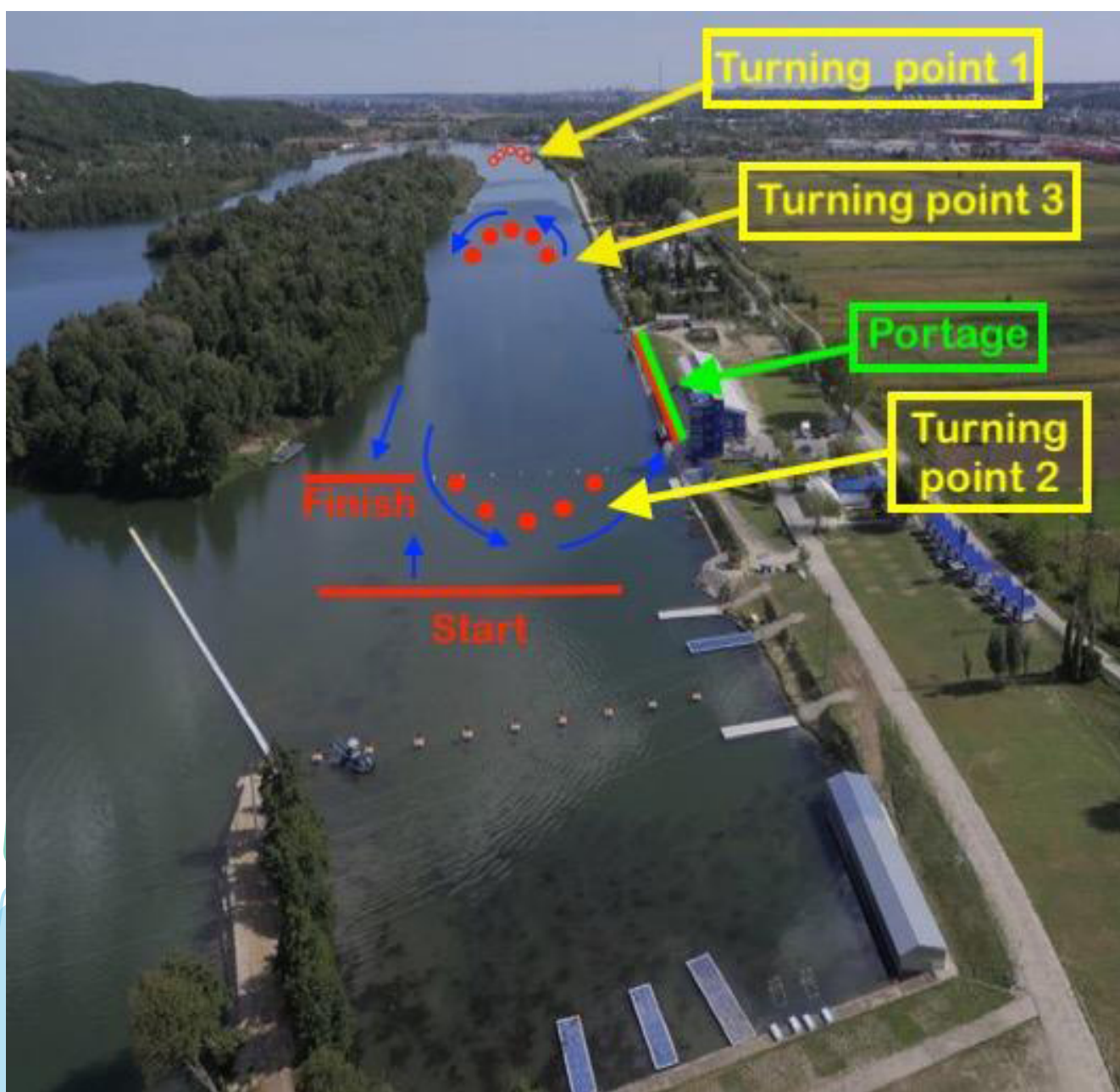

V. DEADLINES, ENTRIES & REGISTRATION

1. Entry and registration Elite and PARA

Entries Para and Elite can only be submitted by the National Federation through the online entries system SDP <https://icf.mev.atos.net/icf/icf.jsp>

The preliminary registrations, travel and accommodation requests from each NF team must be done at <https://memosoft.app/>

Please open the NFS app. It's the newly developed platform by Memosoft, Paddle Europe official technology partner for National Federations participation management.

Any NF that never used the system will need to register and standby for the approval. After approval you may log in and fill in your data. If you have any issues or questions, please contact marcos@memosoft.pt. If you register for other championships in 2026 already you can use the same login.

Preliminary registration is important, so please submit the predicted number of participants and other important information, for example, date of arrival and departure. This will help OC determinate the size of the overall competition and the integration of your team inside the venue and organization.

In the same platform you will be able to select you accommodation needs as well as submit your travelling information and request airport pickup. All processes will be dealt with inside the platform, including pro forma invoicing and confirmation of accommodation and transportation.

2. Entry and registration Masters

Held on **June 21–23**, using the same course and structure as the main events.

VI. ENTRY FEE

1. PARTICIPATION FEE ELITE AND PARA

Each accredited person must pay a participation fee of **30 EUR** per day, covering:

- medical and security service at the venue
- access to the course
- insurance
- free WIFI at the competition venue
- accreditation services
- info desk
- usage of the course/athletes' area during opening hours
- security on the course/athletes' area
- qualified lifeguard on the course during opening hours
- ambulance and/or doctor at the course during opening hours
- drinking water
- toilets & Showers
- electricity
- boats storage facilities
- boat measurements and control facilities
- car and trailer parking
- transport to the hotels, which are booked through organization
- venue access and training

Already included in official accommodation packages.

2. PARTICIPATION FEE MASTERS

- 1 entry: 80 EUR
- 2 entries: 95 EUR
- 3 entries: 110 EUR

Part of the fee will be returned to Paddle Europe for covering ITO's costs and Individual entry system.

Includes accreditation, medical care, and venue services.

VII. ACCOMMODATION & LOGISTICAL SUPPORT

1. Accommodation Elite and Para

Official accommodation is available in PITESTI and Bascov, all within 30 minutes of the competition venue.

 - » Please make payments for the fee incurred by the whole team during their entire stay.
 - » Your reservation will be successful when we receive the advance payment.

Accommodation package fee is to be paid for the length of the team's stay during the access period which starts on Monday June 22nd and ends on Sunday, June 28th.

Considering different categories accommodation package fees are as follows:

All above prices are on per person per day basis, full board (three meals per day).

Lunch will be served at the Venue.

Please keep in mind that because of limited availability of hotel rooms in various categories reservations will be accepted on a 'first-come, first-served' basis which means your team will be redirected to a different category than initially requested if there is not enough space left in the required category. Keep in mind that there a limited number of rooms.

Also, your reservation is only confirmed with the 1st payment being done.

2. Recommendations regarding the accommodation for PARACANOE

- Coordinate with the HOC: Inform the Host Organizing Committee about the number of athletes requiring accessible accommodations. They can assist in coordinating with hotels and arranging necessary services.

The Organizing Committee does not take responsibility for any extra service of the hotel, like mini-bar, telephone, parking, etc., these costs are to be paid directly to the hotel.

In case your team would cause any damage to the rooms you are to pay for it at the hotel before the checkout.

Prices include 3 meals per day and the participating fee.

3. Accomodation for MASTERS

Eligibility: All registered masters may request an accommodation package.

Dates covered:

- Check-in: Saturday, June 20
- Check-out: Wednesday, June 24

What's included:

- Lodging
- Full board (meals included)
- Shuttle from hotel -venue- hotel, during accreditation period

- Same as national federations
- Reduced by **€30 per day** (participation fee discount)

- Caravan stays inside the organization complex must be requested in advance and require confirmation.

4. Payment & deadlines:

The accommodation and participation fees are to be paid as below:

Accommodation: Opens in February until April 20th 2026. Once the HOC confirms your booking, the invoice will be sent. Kindly note that the booking shall be provisional until the payment of the invoice has arrived to our bank account, hence the HOC reserves the right to alter or cancel the reservation until that time.

After April 20th 2026 10% will be added to the package's prices.

With the arrival of the payment, it shall be a confirmed reservation. An updated proforma invoice will be sent by the HOC verifying the arrival of your transfer to our bank account. Participation fee (for those who booked their accommodation on their own and not through the HOC) has to be paid upon the proforma invoice sent by the HOC.

Please, keep the deadline of submitting the nominal entry **June 11 (Masters) June 15, 2026 (Elite and Para)**

30% of the total cost of the reservation must be paid after receiving of the proforma invoice to secure reservation.

70% of the total cost of the reservation must be paid April 20th 2026.

100% of the total cost of the reservation must be paid until May 1st 2026.

5. Cancellation terms:
